A Mission of Compassion

Living in the city of Chicago forces all of us to pay attention to real issues – like poverty, homelessness, and social justice. In one way or another, we're simply confronted with them everyday. Even though we don't have many answers when it comes to solving issues like global poverty, we still feel compelled to help meet people's tangible needs in strategic ways – which is simply an extension of how we already live our lives as followers of JESUS.

Therefore, *30% of MISSION record sales go directly to a compassion fund* where we choose what organizations and people to assist. Here is a list of organizations we have partnered with:

On May 14, 2008 we wired funding to Habitat for Humanity's bank in Indonesia to build one single family home. After completing a show in June, we sent additional funding to HFH on July 12, 2008 to build a second single family residence. We will soon learn where the homes are being built, whom it is for, and receive pictures of the families who will live there when it is completed.

As MISSION, we formed a partnership with Spark Ventures who fund an orphanage and school in Zambia. We will be providing meals for these 250 children for the month of December, 2008.

HEAL Africa works with communities in eastern Democratic Republic of Congo to recognize the potential for development and facilitates the steps at the medical, economic, and social levels. Proceeds from our record have gone to purchase medical supplies that will be used by the HEAL Africa medical staff to attend to the Congolese people.
